Over the past two and a half years, I have created more than 40 human rights and political context analyses, 15 gender analyses and 10 environmental impact assessments, thereby advising upcoming development projects in more than 30 countries on how to avoid unintended negative consequences in these fields and promote a truly inclusive and sustainable approach to development. Furthermore, I was able to successfully conduct an Environmental and Social Impact Assessment and subsequently produced an Environmental and Social Safeguards Framework for conservation projects of the WWF in Cameroon, as well as organise the creation of a new land-rights based project of GIZ in Brazil as Head of the Appraisal Mission. Besides, understanding the formalities of the project cycle, I have been able to successfully support 4 projects in Monitoring, Evaluation and Learning, as well as reporting back to the respective ministry in Germany.
